This part-time position is a critical leadership position within the district and oversees all aspects of fire operations, including fire response preparedness, firefighter recruitment and training, equipment maintenance, and relations with partner agencies. In addition to the Fire Chief position, we continue to have a need for part-time firefighters and EMTs, regardless of experience. 

## DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES UTAH STATE TAX COMMISSION

### CHANGES effective January 1, 2025

- ◆ License plates will be mailed from a central location using USPS
- ◆ Front license plate no longer required
- ◆ DMV will only issue a single license plate
- ◆ Characters on license plates will no longer be embossed - license plates will be flat



- ◆ Month and year decals will be consolidated into a single decal
- ◆ Decal will be displayed in the upper right corner of all license plates


