

BOARD OF CANVASSERS FOR THE JUNE 30, 2020 PRIMARY ELECTION,  
HELD ON JULY 21, 2020 BEGINNING AT 2:00 PM  
IN THE COMMISSION CHAMBERS IN DAGGETT COUNTY, UTAH

*PRESENT:* Commission Chairman Randy Asay; Commissioner Matt Tippetts; Commissioner Jack Lytle and Clerk/Treasurer: Brian Raymond Also present were Shiloh Dupaix and Niel Lund

The Board of Canvass convened at 2:04 pm

Due to the Coronavirus Pandemic the Election held on June 30, 2020 did not include any polling locations or early voting. The County had the option of doing a drive-up vote on election day and opted out of that. Two new secure Ballot Boxes were purchased with Cares Act money (one for Manila and one for Dutch John) and return postage was also placed on the return envelopes, so people did not have to enter the courthouse to vote or return their ballots. Voters needing assistance were offered opportunities for that assistance. Two voters took advantage of the use of the Express Vote machine.

There were 527 By Mail/Absentee ballots issued to voters for Daggett County. Seven ballots came in after Election Day that were originally received by June 30 and were counted and NO ballots came in postmarked *after* the deadline and were not counted. There were 6 ballots that originally did not have matching signatures. All but two were able to be counted. One ballot had voted for both Republican and Democratic races and wasn't counted. Several attempts were made to contact the two voters with signature issues, but they did not return their affidavit.




