

**RESOLUTION 22-04
TO AMEND THE CALENDAR YEAR 2022 BUDGET**

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the County Commission of Daggett County to reopen the Calendar Year 2022 Budget at a public hearing held on May 3, 2022, and

WHEREAS, in order to conform with the Utah State Code and Accounting Procedures as outlined in the Uniform Accounting Manual it is necessary to amend the County budget which states revenues and expenditures for the calendar year ending December 31, 2022.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Daggett County Commission that the following transfers and amendments are to be made to the Calendar Year 2022 Budget:

General Fund 10:

Increase Intergovernmental Revenue by \$2,812 from \$405,146 to \$407,958.

Increase Contributions and Transfers In Revenue by \$114,588, from \$342,156 to \$456,744.

Increase Clerk Expenditures by \$10,710, from \$151,950 to \$162,660.

Decrease Election Expenditures by \$3,210, from \$23,560 to \$20,350.

Increase Ambulance Expenditures by \$104,900, from \$187,450 to \$292,350.

Total General Fund Revenues = \$2,948,672.

Total General Fund Expenditures = \$2,948,672.

Corner Monumentation Fund 77:

Increase Intergovernmental Revenue by \$20,000, from \$0 to \$20,000.

Decrease Contributions and Transfers In by \$5,312, from \$7,812, to \$2,500.


Increase Corner Monumentation Expenditures by \$14,688, from \$7,812 to \$22,500.

Total Corner Monumentation Fund Revenues = \$22,500.

Total Corner Monumentation Fund Expenditures = \$22,500.




