On Election Day, Tuesday, November 5 Ballot Processing, including the following processes: opening ballots, signature verification, scanning ballots, adjudicating ballots, replicating damaged or defective ballots and tabulating votes will occur from 9 am to 12 pm, 2 pm to 5 pm; and 6 pm to 9 pm.
