

2011 REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS
FOR NOXIOUS WEED CONTROL
IN DAGGETT COUNTY

The Daggett County Weed Board in cooperation with Daggett County is seeking to hire a certified contractor to spray noxious weeds on Forest Service, County and private land within Daggett County (See the [County Noxious Weed list](#) for weeds to be targeted).

The specific locations and total available acreage to be controlled will be subject to agreement between the Forest Service, Daggett County and private landowners within Daggett County. The Weed Board reserves the right to reject all bids and to increase the parameters of an agreement should additional funding become available. Maximum contract length is 150 days from signature of contract with a minimum of \$3,000.00 in expenditures and a maximum expenditure of \$13,000.00 unless additional funding is obtained.

Proof of liability insurance and maximum coverage limits must accompany the bid. The winning bidder will also be required to get a Daggett County Business License.

Chemicals used on Forest Service land must be approved in advance. Please list chemicals your firm is interested in using to accomplish the purposes of controlling weeds in Daggett County. Contractor must abide by the safety instructions on the pesticide label. Treatments must be logged and mapped in order for payment to be made.

Please include the following items in your proposal:

- *Proof of current Utah Pesticide applicator certification
- *Proof of Liability insurance
- *List of equipment owned and available for spraying and mapping
- *Cost per acre for backpack spraying
- *Cost per acre for handgun spraying from ATV or Truck
- *Cost per acre for boom spraying
- *Any travel costs or other costs that are not included in previous cost per acre quotes
- *Experience and willingness to seek additional funding for noxious weed control
