Hello:

Flaming Gorge Dam is currently releasing an average daily release of 2,200 cfs. Western Area Power Administration hourly hydropower demand changes throughout the winter. Therefore, beginning November 1, 2015, Flaming Gorge Dam will begin releasing the attached hourly schedule averaging 2,200 cfs/day.

It is anticipated that releases will remain at 2,200 cfs through February 29, 2016. Base flow releases are subject to observed hydrology and all projections may change.
