



## Daggett County Museum Minutes

January 9, 2017

The regular meeting of the Daggett County Museum was held January 9, 2017 in the jury chambers at the county courthouse. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson RaNae Wilde at 12:05 pm. Also those in attendance were Kay Potter, Melna Coleman, MeraDon Ylincheta, Kathy Parkinson, Sara Lamb, Commissioner Clyde Slaugh and a visitor Alexis Walker. Shirley Slaugh asked to be excused and Marie Wilkinson was absent.

Alexis Walker a student at Manila High is interested in the museum and learning more about the history of Daggett County. She would like to be a Museum helper/volunteer.

There are no records of minutes for the meetings held on June 13<sup>th</sup>, July 18<sup>th</sup>, August 8<sup>th</sup>, and August 29<sup>th</sup> 2016. Hopefully Sheila Williams can fill in here.

Discussion was made about a tape recorder. Could we borrow one from the county or should we buy our own. We need a motion for RaNae to buy a tape recorder motion made by Sara Lamb and seconded by Kathy Parkinson. All in favor.

Badges: Sara said she would check on them, she could do that pretty cheap.

Chain Link Fence: Jonah Gonder has not received permission to begin his Eagle Scout Project which is the chain link fence that's to be built on the west side of the museum building.

CCC Building Project: (The first Forest Service Building built by the CCC Camps) We are still pursuing the move of the so-called CCC building also the outhouse.

Donations: RaNae received donations for the museum from the Radosevich's Ranch. They were sent with Jack Lydle and are inside the museum. RaNae also received a Christmas card from Joann Radosevich asking about the buffalo rug which we didn't receive the rug with the other items. Commissioner Slaugh will ask Jack Lytle at commissioners meeting tomorrow about the buffalo rug and RaNae will also check with Joann about it. RaNae talked a little bit about how the buffalo rug and who shot it in Browns Park etc.

Melna stated that Anna Campbell donated tablecloths for the museum and that they are old being hand embroidered. The tablecloths are at Melna's home and when we start cleaning the museum and arranging the new acquired items she will bring them to the museum. As a reminder all new items need to be cataloged in our system.

Sign up sheets or a book: Is there one or do we need to purchase one for visitors to sign in. Do we need a more professional looking book something like at weddings but not white, black would be better. There is a spiral notebook for visitors to sign in the museum.

Grants: There will be grants that we can apply for concerning the museum if someone is interested in writing one. Feel free to do so.

State Historical Society Letter: RaNae received an email letter from Brad Westwood, director of the Utah State Historical Society. They would be glad to put an article in the Utah Historical Magazine of our 100 centennial year. In his letter he mentioned Dr. Holly George and Clint Humphrey.

Winter Program: RaNae will call about having Clint Pumphrey come speak to us for our “ Winter Program” usually held in March. The dates decided were either March 18<sup>th</sup> or 25<sup>th</sup> for this event. If he is not available maybe we could ask for Dr. Holly George.

Centennial Year: After many scenarios for the centennial year whether it be 1917 when it was voted on to be a county or January of 1918 when it became official. It needs to be decided by the commissioners what year or both.

When there is a meeting for the centennial RaNae would like all of us on the Museum Board to be at the meeting and Commissioner Clyde Slaugh stated, as it should be.

After discussion about the year in question could we as a board be ready with a logo chosen from the high schools art class, ordering the varieties of items to sell or give away at the events of the year. It was decided it could be done working together. We could kick it off at the county “Daggett Daze” as suggested. We have the Fishing Derby and Memorial Day in May, the Cow Country Rodeo, and the Jr. Rodeo, the 24<sup>th</sup> of July Parade etc. and the Daggett Daze in September (weekend of Labor Day).

Update on the logo: Kathy was to get with the school to come up with a logo but found out that we need to draft some guidelines for this project. And at the time we didn't have a centennial year to give them. It was decided to not included the elementary in this part of the centennial project but let them do a poster contest.

Date for our next meeting will be held on February 13<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 noon.

More Volunteers: Has anyone asked other people to be on the museum board? Several people have been asked. We have a couple names to invite.
