## UDOT to Restrict Lanes for U.S. 191 Resurfacing

### Expect One-Way Traffic and Travel Delays

Beginning June 4, 2018, through August 2018, the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will resurface a nine-mile section of U.S. 191 from the Daggett/Uintah County line to the junction with State Route 44. This work is part of UDOT's ongoing effort to preserve the existing highway infrastructure by applying roadway treatments to extend the life of the pavement.

#### Anticipated Traffic Delays

Construction crews are planning to work Monday through Thursday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. and Friday, from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Please plan accordingly as drivers will be restricted to one-way traffic and speed limits will be reduced. Motorists should anticipate travel delays of up to 15 minutes. Flaggers and pilot cars will be used to direct drivers through the construction zone. Please slow down and watch for crews working nearby.
