

BOARD OF CANVASSERS FOR THE NOVEMBER 6, 2018 GENERAL ELECTION,
HELD ON NOVEMBER 20, 2018 BEGINNING AT 2:00 PM
IN THE COMMISSION CHAMBERS IN DAGGETT COUNTY, UTAH

PRESENT: Commissioner Chairman Jack Lytle; Commissioner Clyde Slaugh; Commissioner Randy Asay; Clerk/Treasurer: Brian Raymond, Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Margery Hullinger

The Board of Canvas convened.

Daggett County no longer has polling locations throughout the county. We are now an ALL-BY-MAIL/ABSENTEE County. EARLY VOTING took place October 29, 2018 to November 2, 2018 at the Clerk's Office as well as the Dutch John Conference Hall (There were 9 votes cast in Manila and 17 votes in Dutch John). Ballots were mailed in as well as dropped off at the Clerk/Treasurer's Office. The County Courthouse was considered a Vote Center as per Utah Code on Election Day (37 ballots were cast by machine on Election Day).

There were 567 By Mail/Absentee ballots issued to voters in the initial mailing and another 27 ballots in a second mailing. There were 51 ballots returned and only a few were able to be reissued in the second mailing. There were no blank ballots processed; 2 ballots came in postmarked by the deadline; no ballots came in postmarked *after* the deadline; there were 7 provisional ballots that can all be counted, plus there were 5 ballots that did not have matching signatures by the end of Election Day and only one was able to be counted. All persons were contacted, but only one completed and returned their affidavit. There were also six ballots that were returned without a signature and were unable to be counted.

Release dates for ballot uploads to the Lt. Governor's Office for results were November 6, 2018, and today November 20, 2018.

Motion was made by Commissioner Asay and a second by Commissioner Slaugh with all being in favor, so Commission Chairman Jack Lytle declared the 2018 General Election official and the following results final.
